- 2. The late scholar James O. Freedman referred to libraries as "essential harbors on the voyage toward understanding ourselves." What book fiction or non-fiction would you include in your personal library? Why?
- 3. A middle school curriculum does not always allow much intellectual freedom or choice. Describe one of your unfulfilled intellectual passions and discuss briefly how you hope to pursue it.
- 4. "The instructor said, go home and write a page tonight. And let that page come out of you Then, it will be true." "Theme for English B" by Langston Hughes Saying who we are is never simple. Each of us is of a certain age and of a particular family background. We have lived somewhere and been educated. We are each what we feel and see and hear. What a truthful page about yourself for us.
- 5.
